



In term 1 our focus has been to support each child's transition to kindergarten to enable them to develop a sense of belonging so that they feel safe, secure and supported as learners. Teaching in literacy has focused on sharing familiar stories, developing confident reading identities and developing extended vocab around the concept of size. In numeracy we have introduced the 'accurate count' and focused on developing number concept knowledge to 10 through songs, games and rhymes. 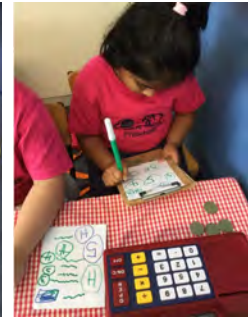
## Literacy
