





<u>Centre Context</u> Adelaide Miethke Preschool offers a program with a strong emphasis on developing children's literacy and numeracy skills. The centre has children enrolled from a wide range of cultural backgrounds. We use play and direct teaching experiences to enable children to develop these in context. Children have opportunities to participate in both indoor and outdoor learning spaces with a focus on learning in and with nature. Inquiry based learning is a feature of the program. Our staff plan and assess the curriculum using the Early Years Learning Framework and report to parents.		

ABOUT THE STATEMENT OF LEARNING

The Statement of Learning is a summary of a child's key learning during their time at preschool. It provides families and schools with information about the knowledge, skills and dispositions the child has demonstrated. The Statement of learning also supports continuity of learning by providing information that will enable the child to transition effectively to a new learning environment.

Early Years Learning Framework

The following learning outcomes within the Early Years Learning Framework (EYLF) are used to describe children's learning:

- Children have a strong sense of identity
- Children are connected with and contribute to their world
- Children have a strong sense of wellbeing
- Children are confident and involved learners
- Children are effective communicators.

Indicators of Preschool Numeracy and Literacy

The indicators of preschool numeracy and literacy describe the child being and becoming numerate and literate. These are evident within each of the 5 learning outcomes described above.


Numeracy indicators:

- I use language to connect with my world
- I understand the language of my world
- I engage with texts and make meaning
