We have noticed growth in the children's willingness and confidence in sharing their experiences and ideas with their peers and adults in various ways throughout the day.

Hunt' enabled the children to make meaning and strong connections and ideas through reading and telling the story many times over, including through puppet making, role playing, bookmaking, drawing and painting the story.

We introduced an 'accurate count' during our small group times, allowing every child to practice counting to and beyond 10 and focused on developing number concepts through stories, songs, games and rhymes.

Within our Child Protection Curriculum we discussed a number of safety aspects including risk assessments in yard, animal safety (dog park), sun safety and how we safely participate as a member of a group in preschool.
